She spoke to them about keeping safe as a pedestrian, how to cross the road correctly in various situations and safety whilst travelling in a car. They practised being aware of their surroundings by crossing various roads using the Green Cross Code.

Green Cross Code

When crossing roads follow these simple steps:

- 1** Always find a safer place to cross, then stop.
- 2** Stand on the pavement, but not too close to the edge of the kerb.
- 3** Look and listen in all directions for any traffic.
- 4** Cross when there is no traffic and there is **enough time** to get to the other side. If you are not sure, don't cross.
- 5** Keep looking and listening for traffic as you cross.
- 6** Walk straight across the road. Do not run.
