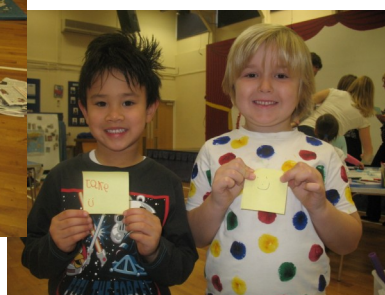

On Bonfire night we let Fireworks into the sky.

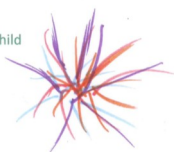
Not 1 firework should be touched by a child

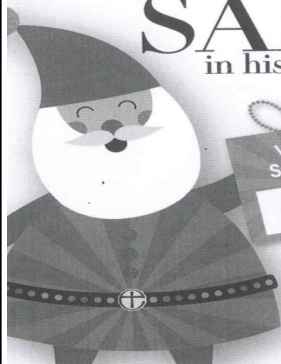
