



A Gunpowder Plot Day

On Tuesday Lime and Cherry Classes had a topic day on the Gunpowder Plot which is our topic for this term. It was a brilliant day, the children acted out the main events and filmed themselves using an iPad app. They talked about gunpowder and learnt how chemical reactions take place. Experiments were carried out using bicarbonate of soda, white vinegar, food colouring and glitter. The children themselves tested different liquids to find out how they reacted with bicarbonate of soda and inflated a balloon with the carbon dioxide that was produced. Portraits were drawn of Thomas Percy and barrels were made to carry home exploding biscuits. Tasting popping candy was a new experience for many children and the look on their faces said it all. We were very fortunate to have OFSTED visiting us that day as the Inspector was able to see first-hand how well topic is taught at Hutton All Saints'.
