**An additional Flu clinic is being held in Brentwood on the 16<sup>th</sup> December for those children who have not yet received the flu vaccine.**

This vaccination programme is in place to help protect your child against flu. Flu can be an unpleasant illness and sometimes causes serious complications. Vaccinating your child will also help protect more vulnerable friends and family by preventing the spread of flu. This vaccination is free and recommended for children up to year 7. Last year, most children offered the immunisation in schools had the vaccine.

Achieving high flu vaccination rates is essential to protecting our children and communities during the COVID pandemic and from preventing the NHS from being overwhelmed this winter. Please call if you would like to book an appointment to have your child vaccinated with the flu nasal spray vaccine on the above number.

Additionally, a national decision has therefore been made to offer the **inactivated flu injection that doesn't contain pork** as an alternative for children whose parents declined the nasal flu vaccine for their children on account of the porcine content. The Fluenz nasal spray remains the most effective flu vaccine for children however if you would prefer for your child to receive the injectable flu vaccine please call.
