



This term we are learning about animals and the weather.

During English we will be working hard to try and use capital letters, full stops and finger spaces in every sentence we write now. We will begin by looking at some exciting fantasy stories, non-fiction and later on, focus on rhyme and poetry. This term we will be consolidating all of our phonic knowledge so far and continuing with phase 5. The children will be taking their phonics screening check in June.

In Maths we will be starting to look at multiplication and division. This will involve counting in 2s, 5s and 10s. We will look at fractions by finding a half and quarter of a number and shape. In the second half term we will look at time, where we will learn to tell the time to o'clock and half past. In addition, we will focus on money by recognising the value of different coins and adding simple totals together.

In Science, we will learn all about plants. We will find out about the conditions they need to grow, how their seeds spread and the names of the different parts of plants. We will also be looking at different types of weather and even get to act as weather reporters!

Our Topic this term is animals. We will find out lots of interesting facts about where different animals live, how they have adapted to their environment and what they eat. In art lessons we will experiment with different media to replicate animal prints.

In RE we will be learning about the religion of Islam. Our Christian values for this term are 'Wisdom' and 'Responsibility'.

In our PE lessons we will be developing our athletics skills by taking part in lots of fun multi-sports activities. We will be learning more about running quickly and throwing and catching.

This term in computing, we will have lots of discussions about the importance of E-Safety. Practically, we will focus on algorithms and basic computer skills such as typing.

Our PSHE topics this term will be our personal safety and managing change.
