During the first half term we will be looking at stories with historical settings. In the following half term we will be reading and creating our own play scripts.

Maths

This term in maths we will be learning about:

- Multiplication and Division; the formal short methods.
- Fractions and Decimals; finding equivalent fractions, adding and subtracting fractions and rounding decimals to whole numbers.

Topic

- What did Tudor people wear?
- Where did Tudor people live?
- What did Tudor people do for fun?
- What happened to Henry VIII's wives?

Science-Friday mornings with Mrs Whitbread

This term we will be learning about living things and their habitats. We will group living things, explore classification keys and recognise that environments can change which can pose dangers to living things.

R.E. & P.S.H.E.

In R.E. we will continue our learning about the impact of Pentecost. Children will explore the idea of the Trinity. Then we will learn about Jesus' life and the kind of world Jesus would want.

In PSHE we will learn how to be responsible with money and the different things adults use money for. Then we are going to be learning about the human life cycle and the responsibilities parents have for babies and children. We will also discuss what it means to 'grow up' and the changes that happen to our bodies.
