

THE ROMANS AND BRITAIN

Maths

This term in maths we will be learning about:

- Multiplication and Division; we will learn how to use the formal written methods.
- Fractions and Decimals; finding equivalent fractions, adding and subtracting fractions and rounding decimals to whole numbers.
- Measurement; how to find the area of a rectilinear shape.

Science

This term we will learn about living things and their habitats. We will use classification keys to group living things and explore how environments change and the dangers this can pose to living things. We will then find out about animals, including humans. We will describe the functions of the digestive system, identify the different types of teeth in humans and construct food chains.

P.S.H.E.

This half term in our P.S.H.E. lessons we will be learning about how our bodies change as we get older and develop our understanding of medicine, finding out which drugs are safe.

Topic

Our Topic for this term is 'The Romans' We will begin by exploring the different parts of the Roman Empire. We will learn about the impact that the Romans had on Britain. We will look at the invasions of Julius Caesar and Claudius and will learn about the unsuccessful rebellion of Boudicca. Once we have an understanding of the history of the Roman Empire we will learn about their culture. We will learn about their buildings including Hadrian's Wall and Roman baths. We will also create some mosaics, helmets and shields.

In R.E. lessons we will continue to learn about incarnation. We will consider what it means for Jesus to be God in human form and we will develop our understanding of the Trinity. After half term we will learn about Easter and the Christian belief of salvation.
