

# Lime and Cherry Spring Term 2019

## Toys and Games through time



Throughout our 'Toys and Games through time' topic, the children will develop a range of historical skills such as: asking and answering questions, identifying and interpreting different sources and recognising change and exploring how this influences them today.

In Maths, Year 2 will be looking at:

Multiplication and division, making equal groups, using arrays and solving problems with the 2x,5x and 10x tables; statistics, collecting data and answering questions about it; shapes and learning the names and properties; fractions of shapes and numbers; measurements of length and height.

Year 1 will be looking at:

Addition and subtraction; place value; measurements of length and height, weight and volume. We will also be counting in 2s,5s and 10s.



Thursday Swimming lessons will run through the first half of this term for the year 2 children in **group A** and then swap after half term to **group B**. The remaining children will be developing their skills in a range of other games.

Lime class children will take part in net and wall skills and activities (indoors) on Tuesdays for the first half of term and will learning about striking and fielding (outdoors) in the second half on Fridays.

Cherry class children will take part in net and wall skills on Fridays for the first half of term and will be learning striking and fielding skills in the second half on Tuesdays.

In Science, Lime and Cherry will be studying materials and looking at their properties, deciding which is best for a particular job.

In RE we will be deepening our understanding of Christianity, learning about salvation.

In PSHE, Lime class will be learning about relationships and working together, financial capability and drug awareness. Cherry class will also be learning about drug awareness, communities and citizenship.

In English the year 1 children will be continuing to learn their phonics, whilst in year 2 they will be continuing the spelling strategies. In writing we will continue to improve our handwriting, grammar and punctuation through writing a range of stories, instructions, recounts and poems.

In DT we will be learning about making moving images and joining materials.

In ICT we will revisit the rules on staying safe online. We will learn how to mix sound, graphics and animations using a variety of apps on the iPads.

In Music we are going to create and compose short pieces to accompany our animations using long and short sounds.
