

Pear Summer Term 2019



In Maths , Pear Class will be looking at:

Addition and subtraction using number lines and other manipulatives to solve missing number calculations; multiplication and division through using arrays, grouping and sharing leading onto number fractions; money and time.

In Science, Pear class will be learning about plants and the weather. We will be linking this to our topic and looking closely at the variety of insects and minibeasts which visit our school gardens.

In Art, we will be creating textured collages and models of minibeasts; we will also be designing a model of a room in a house.

In ICT, we will revisit the rules on staying safe online. We will learn about how to handle data using a variety of programmes and apps on both the iPads and the notebook tablets.

In Music, we will be learning songs and rhymes about animals and performing songs accompanied by percussion.



Throughout our 'Houses and homes' Topic, the children will looking at different types of homes, e.g. bungalows and flats, and how homes are adapted to different climates. We will also be looking closely at minibeasts, naming their body parts and learning how some of them can help in the garden.

In English, Pear Class will be continuing to focus on their phonics, in preparation for the Year 1 Phonic Screening Check which will take place in JUNE 2019. In writing we will continue to improve our handwriting, grammar and punctuation through writing a range of stories, information texts, character descriptions and descriptive poems.

Pear class children will take part in athletics (outdoors) for the first half of term and will be learning fitness and dance activities (indoors) in the second half .

In RE we will be deepening our understanding of Christianity, as well as learning about Judaism.

In PSHE, Pear class will also be learning about personal safety and managing change. Our school values this term are Truthfulness and Service.
