Covid Update

Please remember that we are currently in a national lockdown until 2nd December. This means that we have been advised to stay at home where possible, and that we must not meet with people from different households, unless they are part of your support bubble. It is therefore extremely important that you maintain distance at the gates and do not let children from different bubbles mix while you are waiting.

If someone in your household has any covid symptoms, the **whole household must isolate** until a negative test result has been received. After the person with symptoms has received a negative test result, your child may then return to school if they are not showing any symptoms themselves. If someone in your **household tests positive**, current guidelines state that you must all isolate for 14 days, even if other family members receive a negative test result. This is due to the incubation period of the virus. **Please let the school know immediately if anyone in your household tests positive.**

If your child is tested due to being symptomatic and receives a negative result, and no member of your household tests positive, your child may return to school once they feel well enough. The three main symptoms to look out for are: a **high temperature**, a **new and continuous cough**, and a **loss or change to your sense of smell or taste**. Please re-read our guidelines sent in September 2020.

The AGM is taking place **tonight at 8pm** via Microsoft Teams.


