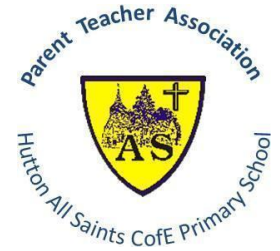


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Minutes of PTA AGM Tuesday 21st October 2025

School's Wish List 2025/26

Mrs Manookian gave an overview of the items that the school would like the PTA to continue to fund over the next academic year.

Mrs Manookian explained the school were looking to update the old Thinking Area into a Thinking and Role Play Area but plans and ideas have changed slightly.

All of the following items were passed and the PTA are able to pay for the following:

- Times Table Rock Stars Subscription - for the annual subscription. TTRS is used by children from year two – year six
- Year 6 – First Aid Training – this is a very useful resource for the year 6 students and has become a tradition.
- Panto Coaches – school will ask for a voluntary donation from parents to pay for the coaches to the panto. The PTA will fund the shortfall which is approximately £1500
- Kids inspire £3000
- Class cameras x3 £600
- IT iPad set (17 iPads) - £7500
- Thinking area upgrade and Fit Tag cupboard restock - £10000

Mrs Manookian also expressed wish that further fundraising go towards:

- Additional iPad sets
- Two additional playground canopies (like the large one already in the playground) approx £9000
