


WELL DONE to Alkinoos, who earnt his Level 1 Gymnastics badge from South Essex gymnas-tics club.

DOODLE STATISTICS

We have been using Doodle at Hutton All Saints' since November 2020. It is paid for out of the Universal Catch Up Premium grant, which is awarded to schools to ensure that they have the support they need to help all pupils make up for missed learning during the pandemic.

Here are a few amazing statistics from our first year of Doodling (from November 2020 to November 2021):

- 256,793 questions were answered**
- Average question time: 17 seconds**
- 1,213 hours of practice were carried out**
- 140 of the pupils were active users**
- 7,087 progress steps were made by learners**

AMAZING STREAKS!

Some more children have now achieved a 365 day streak on Doodle Maths, English and Spell. This means that they have Doodled every day for a whole year (even on Christmas Day!). This is amazing dedication to their learning.
