Apple class science lesson

This week Apple class have been learning about the differences between materials.



They experimented by spraying different solutions on their snowmen to see how quickly they melted. They used salt water, vinegar and water, and the third snowman was left at room temperature. The children predicted which snowman would melt first, and drew their observations at different intervals throughout the day.



(The snowman which was sprayed with salt water melted the quickest!)
