Anti-Bullying week

This week is Anti-Bullying week, and 'ONE KIND WORD' has been chosen as the theme for 2021. Throughout the school, children have learnt the importance of being kind and how one kind word can lead to another. Children have discussed what they could do if they or someone else is being bullied and the importance of speaking out.

Each year group has participated in a variety of activities. The Juniors all watched a production on-line called 'Hope'. It explored the theme of bullying and what to do if they feel that they are being bullied. This was then discussed further in class during P.S.H.E lessons.



The Infants sorted pictures into 'kind' and 'unkind' categories and discussed how they could help others or what they could do in different scenarios, particularly if they felt that they were being bullied. Pear class have also been exploring books which celebrate differences.

Apple class created a large heart and decorated it using their hand prints, and wore odd socks to illustrate that we are 'all different but we are all the same.'


