

As part of their topic, Pine and Beech class enjoyed a virtual tour of the British Museum yesterday. "Yesterday, we had a virtual tour of the British Museum on Zoom, during our topic lesson. We talked about the Egyptians and what type of stuff they had. The pictures of the artefacts were amazing! Here are some of the things they had in the museum:

Rosetta Stone, Sphinx and the Gold plated silver figurine of the Egyptian God Amun-Ra. We also did an interview on the app Kahoot and we did some questions in groups of three on the iPads. My favourite part was when I learnt about the Rosetta Stone and it was very fascinating with all the artefacts. It was very fun and I enjoyed it a lot." *Macie*.


