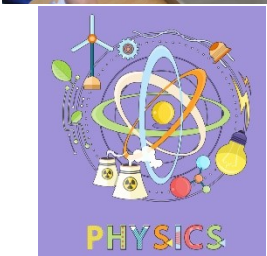
Please take particular note of two notices on page 3 regarding extra clothes in school and a parking and social distancing reminder.

Willow class have thoroughly enjoyed their physics lesson this week. They have been learning about friction and enjoyed a fun "boat race" to see how a streamlined body can be affected by water drag. They learnt about solubility, and carried out a "Dissolving Sugar" experiment. They identified dependent, independent and controlled variables, made accurate results, and drew valid conclusions.

Well done year 5 and 6!







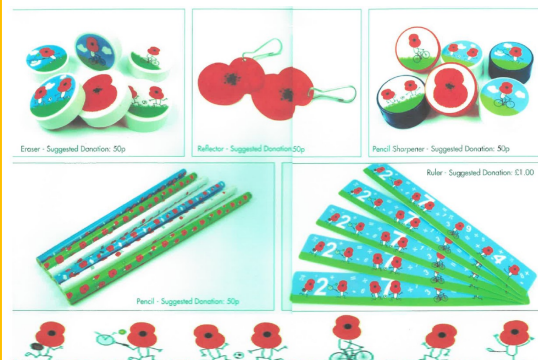
## Secondary School Admissions September 2021

## Waterproof coats and old clothes and shoes in school

## Parking and social distancing reminder

Please remember to keep **2 metres apart** at the gates, as per current guidelines. If your child has gone in, please move along so other children can get to their classes without having to walk in the road.

It is also very important that you **do not park on the yellow lines outside of school**. It is prohibited at all times for the safety of children walking into school. Many of our year 6 children have started walking to school alone, so please be considerate of all children if you drive to school.
