If your child develops any symptoms of COVID-19 on Saturday 19th or Sunday 20th December:

You must seek a test for your child. <https://www.gov.uk/get-coronavirus-test>
Your household must isolate until the test result is returned.
You must email admin@huttonallsaints.essex.sch.uk stating: child's name, class, day that symptoms first started and day of test.

If your child is asymptomatic, but takes a test on Saturday 19th or Sunday 20th December:

TEST RESULT RECEIVED

POSITIVE RESULT

Inform admin@huttonallsaints.essex.sch.uk .
We will identify if there are any other individuals within the school community who are impacted by this and inform them by email.
Continue to follow all NHS guidelines.

NEGATIVE RESULT

Inform admin@huttonallsaints.essex.sch.uk .
You do not need to take any further action.

If your child develops any symptoms of COVID-19 after Sunday 20th December:
You must seek a test for your child. <https://www.gov.uk/get-coronavirus-test>
Your household must isolate until the test result is returned.
If the test result is positive, you must contact NHS Test and Trace and follow the advice given by them:
www.nhs.uk/conditions/coronavirus-covid-19/testing-and-tracing/

Please inform us by Sunday 3.1.21 if your child will be absent at the start of the new term.

Santa Dash

Here are the Santa Dash results: 12 schools from across the Brentwood district took part, which was a total of 2558 children running for 15 minutes.

Averages were worked out for each year group, with the top 3 receiving prizes of sweets from Shenfield High School.

Pear Class were 4th out of all the year 1 children with an average of 1800m.

Lime and Cherry were joint 5th in year 2. Also with an average of 1800m

In year 3, Beech class were 3rd with 2152m per pupil - Well done Beech!

Pine were 9th in year 4 with 1420m per pupil.


Willow finished 5th with an average of 2570m and Sycamore were also 5th with 2681m each.


If you would like to follow Santa on Christmas Eve, he will be starting at 4:30pm and following the route below.



Brentwood a Becket Rotary Club will again be helping Santa in Hutton on Christmas Eve


