Josh "I enjoyed eating the frogs legs - it was my first time and I liked it!"

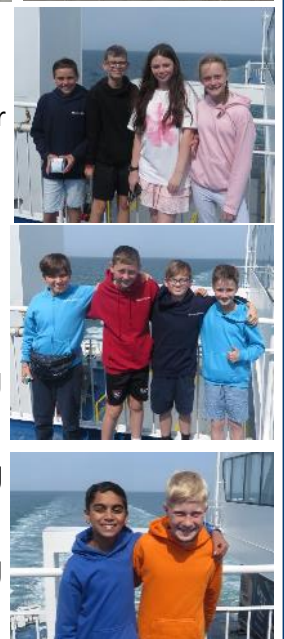
Eva "I liked practising my French in the market and ordering the food for our picnic!"
