

In **English**, we will continue to improve handwriting, grammar and punctuation through writing a range of text types which includes letters, recounts, stories and information texts. RWI schemes will be continuing to work on phonic strategies and reading.

In **Science**, we will be learning about animals including humans, their young, how to look after them and their lifecycles. We will look at how to keep ourselves healthy through exercise and a balanced diet. Also we will look at hygiene and how to combat the spread of germs.

In **Maths** this term, we will be looking at: Subtraction, Money, Multiplication and Division, Properties of 2D and 3D Shape and Measurements.

In **Topic** this term, the children will be learning about the country of India: its climate, geographical and cultural features. We will use our mapping skills to learn and look up information about the continents and oceans.

In **Computing**, we will revisit the rules on staying safe online, and how technology helps us in everyday life. We will also be learning how to program robots, learning about algorithms and debugging.



In **Art**, we will be learning about the Brazilian artist Romero Britto. We will also be exploring the repeating patterns seen in Indian art and textiles, and will create and print some of our own.

In **D.T**, we will be preparing food.

We will be having a **TOPIC WEEK** (12th-16th February), to enhance our learning about India.

This half term, our **school value** is **Courage**, and next half term it is **Forgiveness**.

In **RE**, we will be learning about why Easter is important to Christians and deepening our understanding about Salvation through the story of Easter.

In **PSHE**, we will be exploring Relationships looking at friendships, manners, respect and strategies to resolve conflict. In our Wider World unit, we will be learning about online safety, the internet and keeping personal data safe.

In **Music**, we will use the theme of 'superheroes' to explore links between sounds and words when composing and will use a range of vocal, body percussion and instruments to perform. We will listen and appraise our own and other's work as well as listen to a famous piece of music written by John Williams.

On **Mondays**, Lime class will take part in **swimming lessons**.

On **Tuesdays**, Lime class children will take part in dance.
