It was Mrs White's birthday last week. She celebrated at home with her family and had this delicious cake!





Sonny has been having fun practising archery in his garden.



Evie has been practising her handwriting; Brodie has been doing maths; Matthew and Violet enjoyed a game of Grapheme Bingo!




