On Tuesday, the year 5/6 dodgeball team went to Shenfield High School to take part in the Partnership competition. Dodgeball is a fast-paced game where you throw balls at the opposition and try not to get hit by one of their balls whilst doing so. Games are won by getting all of the opposition out before the time runs out or having the most players left on the court. The team was Semi, Tommy, Freya, Iris, Todd, Samuel, Sam, Nicholas, Jack and Evie.
