- ✓ Skreens park will provide us with lunch before we head home.

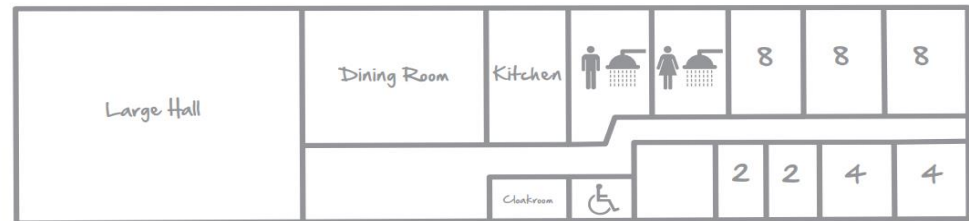
*Catering is of a high standard, under the supervision of a qualified chef.
