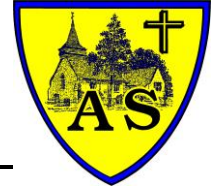

Dear Parents and Carers,

Please find attached the new club timetable for Spring Term 2024. If you would like your child to attend a club before or after school, application slips can be found at the bottom of this letter. We ask that children indicate their first, second and third choice for a club. We then allocate places to each of the clubs, depending on these choices. **Please return slips by 3pm on Friday 5<sup>th</sup> January.** Children will find out if they have places by Friday 12<sup>th</sup> January and school-run clubs will start the week commencing Monday 15<sup>th</sup> January. Once selected for a club, your child will be given details of where it will take place, and any extra arrangements, such as clothing. School run clubs will run weekly - the last week of clubs will be Monday 11<sup>th</sup> March so from 15<sup>th</sup> March to the end of term there will be no school run clubs. Please see the letter sent by external providers for their course dates.

**PLEASE NOTE: P.A.S.S Academy, Basketball, Musical Theatre and Kazen Kai Kick Boxing must be booked via the provider directly (forms have been sent out separately for these clubs).**

Once your child has committed to a club they must be punctual, and if for any reason they cannot attend the club, they must inform the teacher who is running it (with a letter from you also). Please make a note of the starting time for our morning clubs, as the teacher/coach can only let them in all at the same time.

Once again, we are focusing on clubs which will improve the children's physical and mental health. There is a fantastic number and range of clubs available to the children again this term. Thank you to all staff who give up their time to make this possible.

This year we will be subsidising outside agency sports clubs using our P.E. funding. This makes it more accessible for more families. Please ensure your child attends if they have committed to these clubs, as the school will be invoiced. We ask that parents also make their payments promptly. These clubs usually have a waiting list; therefore, if a payment is not made, your child's place will be re-allocated to another pupil.
