

English

This term, we will be focusing on writing descriptive settings, using our history knowledge to write our own. We will be reading and creating our own play scripts and letters to authors.

Maths

This term in maths we will be learning about:

- Multiplication and division
- Fractions
- Measures.

R.E. & P.S.H.E.

Science

During the first half term we will be studying animals including humans, looking at healthy growth and nutrition. In the second half term, we will be studying forces and magnets.

Topic

We will be learning about the Tudors this term and looking at the following key questions:

- Who were the Tudor Royals?
- What were Tudor homes and buildings like?
- What was life like for people in Tudor times?

We can't wait to show you our learning at our class assembly on the 28th January. We also have a trip to the Tower of London on the 10th February as part of our Topic Week.

We will continue to have swimming sessions on a Monday for the whole term. Our other PE slot is now on Tuesday and will be Tag Rugby and then Tennis.

Computing

We will use the Scratch programming area to learn about sequencing commands, with a focus on creating sounds. Later in the term we will learn about databases, how they are made and their uses.

Using Castles as a theme, we will explore rhythmic composition and later use poetry to learn the language of music.



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
