

Summer Term 2025

English

In English, we will firstly be revising for our tests. We will go over all of the G.P.S. rules and vocabulary we have learnt, ensuring we can answer related questions and apply our knowledge to our writing. When we are writing, we will focus on a few key areas: planning a variety of text types; including features relevant to the text type; ensuring our writing has a clear structure and showcasing a range of appropriate punctuation and impressive vocabulary. With our reading comprehension, we will practise answering questions carefully and clearly, using evidence from the text to support our ideas.

Topic

Our Topic this term is Pre-history (Stone Age to Iron Age). We will study the lives of prehistoric people and compare them to our own lives. We will also look into the differences between the Neolithic, Bronze and Iron Ages in Britain.

French

In preparation for our trip to France in June, we will be revising the key phrases and words we might need during our visit.

Year Six

Maths

As with English, we will spend the first part of the term consolidating and extending our knowledge as we prepare for our tests. We will then develop our maths investigation skills where we can put all of our knowledge into real-life scenarios, trying to solve a number of mathematical problems.

Music

In our first unit, pupils will take inspiration from Vivaldi's 'The Four Seasons, Winter' to explore and create soundscapes. For the second unit, pupils will be comparing music from romantic and 20th century composers.

This term we will focus on volleyball, yoga, rounders and tennis. The yoga will coincide with the SATs build up and tests, so that we can learn some helpful relaxation and mindfulness techniques.

Art & DT

In art we will consider cave art from the Iron and Stone age. We will experiment with techniques to recreate these primitive art forms. We will also be working on a set design project.

Science

In our Science lessons we will continue with our unit on Electricity, then go on to learn about Living Things and their habitats.

Computing

During our computing lessons, we will learn how to create a website. We will consider what makes a good website, the layout of a webpage and when it may be appropriate to include links.
